

Descriptive Writing:

Describe a Natural Feature of Dublin

Directions: Show what you have learned about our local geography by writing a description of a geographical feature that is in our region. Think about what you know about the natural land and water features that we have here in the Dublin area and choose one to describe. Examples are things like Mt. Diablo, Tassajara Creek, the hills, etc.

- Use descriptive words and phrases to describe how your feature looks, how it sounds, how it smells, and how it feels.
- Include details and facts about your landform or body of water. Examples of facts might include things such as the effects of the seasons on it, plants and local wildlife found there, where you would find this feature, its history and importance to the region.
- Keep your writing focused.
- Make sure you have edited your writing (PICS: punctuation, indent, capitalization, and spelling).
- Make sure you have used your neatest writing or have typed it yourself.
- Include a drawing or find photographs of your geographical feature.
